- **2. School Board Self-Evaluation** We received MSBA's new School Board Self-Evaluation this week in the form of an online evaluation tool. I will visit with Board Chair Rick Schultz to see if the Board will be interested in applying this tool as it reflects on progress made toward the Board's four goals this year. Below is a communication sent this week.

Dear Superintendent and Board Chair,

Minnesota School Boards Association is excited to launch our newest service for school boards. The **School Board Self-Evaluation** is a reliable and valid instrument developed with the BERC Group and Anderson Data Solutions. It is available electronically via a personalized survey link. MSBA is providing this basic service at no additional cost to school districts.

The **School Board Self-Evaluation** is online and the personalized link in the message below takes you to the evaluation that has been designated for your school district. The results are collected and reported to the board chair and superintendent, coming from board as a whole (individual responses remain confidential). After the superintendent and all school board members have submitted their evaluations, our system generates a one-page aggregate report. This report will provide you with feedback on each of the five standards/role of the school board pillars (Vision, Structure, Accountability, Advocacy and Conduct and Ethics) as well as how your board team responded. It will allow your board to analyze the results from the standards level. MSBA will deliver the report to the board chair and superintendent via email.

We believe school districts will find it beneficial to drill down to individual items under the benchmarks. If your school board would like to dig deeper into the **School Board Self-Evaluation** and data, MSBA provides an opportunity to use your evaluation data as an in-district inservice for a fee. During this 2 - 3 hour in-service, MSBA staff will provide your school board with more in-depth individualized data and reports designed for the board's ongoing improvement. MSBA staff will lead the conversation on the individualized report and assist your school board with discussion and setting board team improvement goals.

Prior to forwarding the message (below) to your school board, MSBA suggests that you include the **School Board Self-Evaluation** as a board meeting agenda item so school board members are familiar with it when you email it to them. At the time of the discussion, you might also want to suggest a timeline for completing the survey (i.e. suggest that once they receive it, they should complete it within five business days).
