Most immediate is to begin meeting with key staff to begin the design work for classrooms and the Elementary School entrance. Much of this work will be done through June.

- 8. Summer Board Work Sessions As shared at the Board meeting, I encourage the Board to schedule a Budget work session this summer. After meeting with Rick Schultz this morning and looking at calendars, we have targeted the weeks of July 8 or July 15 as potential times to hold a work session. The July regular School Board meeting is July 15 so we may want to first look at Monday, July 8, or Tuesday, July 9. We will follow-up with Board members to see what the best dates would be.

The Board also meets annually in July/August to conduct a self-evaluation of the Board's work over the past year and then sets goals for the coming year. That Board has also set the Superintendent's work goals for the upcoming school year at this time as well. If not in July, we will need to set a work session in early August for the purpose of the Board's self-evaluation and goal setting.
