- 4. Summer Board Work Sessions As shared at the Board meeting, I encourage the Board to schedule a Budget work session this summer. We have targeted the weeks of July 8 or July 15 as potential times to hold a work session. A doodle survey was sent to Board members for you to respond to.

The Board also meets annually in July/August to conduct a self-evaluation of the Board's work over the past year and then sets goals for the coming year. That Board has also set the Superintendent's work goals for the upcoming school year at this time as well. If not in July, we will need to set a work session in early August for the purpose of the Board's self-evaluation and goal setting.

5. Waseca County Trauma in Schools Forum Planning– There is interest among the three school districts in Waseca County (NRHEG, Waseca, J-W-P) along with South Central Human Services to facilitate a county wide forum on the growing challenge of servicing students who are experiencing increased mental health and behavioral challenges at school, home, and in the community. New Richland Lions President, Dan Schmidt, and I will be attending a planning meeting on Tuesday, June 18, in Waseca, to begin discussing and planning for the forum. A first step is to engage community leaders in the conversation and planning as it needs to be more than the school districts facilitating this. More information to come.
