<u>Job Share Requests for 2018-2019</u> – The Board approved the paraprofessional job share team for 2018-2019 of Judith Tweeten and Lori Tomsche at the Secondary School.

<u>English Language Learner (ELL) Translator Letter of Agreement</u> – The Board approved the ELL Translator Letter of Agreement for Norris Hemingway. The position will support transition needs for three elementary students who moved to the District this semester and are limited in English.

<u>2017-2018 Winter Coaching Contract Adjustments</u> – The Board approved adjusting the coaching salaries for three winter sports coaches due to increased responsibilities experienced during the winter season. The following coaches assumed additional responsibilities of coaching the C-Squad teams as both the boys' and girls' basketball teams did not have a C-Squad specific coach. The three coaches include:

- a. Drew Paukert Adjustment of \$1,000.
- b. Isaiah Lundberg Adjustment of \$750
- c. Pat Churchill Adjustment of \$250

Facilities

<u>Daktronics LED Football Stadium Scoreboard and Accessories</u> – The Board approved the purchase and installation of a new scoreboard for our stadium for the total quoted price from Daktronics of \$25,674.00. The purchase is funded through Long Term Facility Maintenance (LTFM).

<u>Technology Replacement and Upgrades</u> – The Board approved the recommendation to accept a quote from CTS of Mankato to move the main wiring closet which is currently located in The DMZ at the Secondary School, to Angie's office. This will provide security that is needed for this equipment. The quote also included replacing/upgrading the access points and wireless controllers in the district, which have reached "end of life" status. The project will be finalized closer to the installation date this summer. The project in its entirety will be dependent on eRate funding from the state, which should cover approximately 60 percent of the total cost, up to \$80,000.

Board Governance
