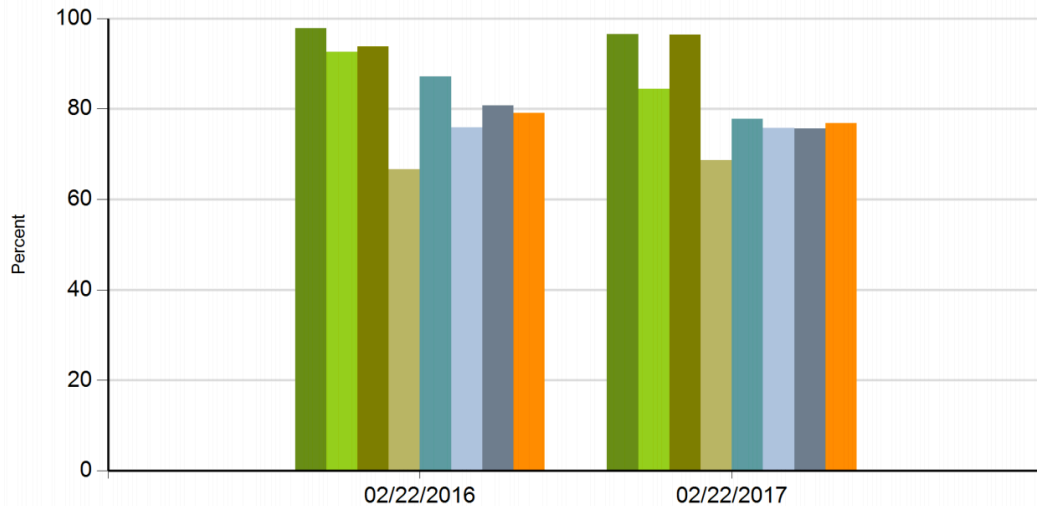

6. On November 27, educational consultant, Nancy Remmert, worked with our elementary staff in the morning. Topics that day focused on determining prerequisite skills for standards work and focusing on the intended level of rigor (What does proficient student work look like and sound like).
7. Parent Teacher Conferences were held from 12:00-8:00 p.m. on February 27. Data collected from teachers shows that 93% of our elementary families attended conferences. Other data regarding the conference schedule and preferred conference times was also collected.
8. Climb Theatre was in our school on February 28 and March 1 and made 45-minute presentations to each classroom related to friendship, communication and anti-bullying techniques. A survey completed by Climb Theatre shows that 100% of our staff members request that they return again next year for another performance. This is the second year that Climb Theatre has been at our school.
9. A Self Assessment Survey (SAS) was provided to all staff members at the elementary to gauge the effectiveness of our PBIS program. The Elementary PBIS Leadership Team will be reviewing these results and determining what, if any, changes will be made to our PBIS program. Information from the survey is presented below:
